

Roanoke Star Participation Fees 2010-11

Roanoke Star is firmly established as THE club in the Roanoke Valley for Player Development. Although we do not feel there is any comparison when evaluating other local area clubs it is important to consider the opportunities available at Roanoke Star when compared to other clubs in the area. Roanoke Star is delighted to expand on the many services it is able to offer to the players this year. Our quality coaching staff is already amongst the best in Virginia and we will be welcoming a few new additions to the staff this year. The following is a list of the services that all players will receive as Roanoke Star players. All the services offered below are included in the participation fees for 2010-11 – an incredible value for the Roanoke Star player! The list is extremely extensive so please read it carefully!

- ****NEW FOR 2010 – INCLUDED IN PARTICIPATION FEES**** The Edge Sports Performance Conditioning Training. This year Roanoke Star players will enjoy one night per week of Soccer Speed and Agility Training with the qualified professionals at “The Edge”. The training will take place at the Edge Sports Performance Center on Tom Andrews Road and will be classed as a 3rd night training for all Roanoke Star players.
- ****NEW FOR 2010 – INCLUDED IN PARTICIPATION FEES**** Functional Skills training – Roanoke Star players will have the opportunity to participate in additional functional training sessions (3rd night training) run by staff coaches as well as coaches from outside the club including college coaches.
- ****NEW FOR 2010 – INCLUDED IN PARTICIPATION FEES**** Online Player Evaluation service. Roanoke Star players will have no problems receiving feedback from their coaches as they will have access to an evaluation service that offers quality feedback from the coaches on a regular basis. Players will receive important tips to improve their game as well as have the opportunity to evaluate their own performance and receive feedback on their evaluation.
- ****NEW FOR 2010 – INCLUDED IN PARTICIPATION FEES**** Indoor Soccer training facilities. Every year around October in the Roanoke area, a lack of fields, bad weather and fading light cause real problems for teams to train. This year, all Roanoke Star teams will train indoors from October 25th until the end of the season. The cost for training indoors will not be an extra for players; it is included in the participation fees! The benefits to the players will be huge as the risk of training postponements will be virtually eliminated.
- ****NEW FOR 2010 – INCLUDED IN PARTICIPATION FEES**** Extended season. In accordance with our player development philosophy, we feel it is important to offer more training opportunities for our players. We have therefore extended our season for all teams in both the fall and spring. We are confident that the extra training sessions will help improve the

technical, tactical, physical and mental capabilities of our players and the rewards will be well received by players and families.

- ****NEW FOR 2010 – INCLUDED IN PARTICIPATION FEES****. Elite teams aged U11-U15 will benefit from two coaches per team. This will allow for a more personal touch to coaching and therefore, increased player development. It will also allow for our coaches to work even closer together and enable opportunities to grow the training pool of players (for example, by inviting Premier players to train with Elite teams without putting too much stress on 1 coach working with vast numbers of players) which will provide players with additional opportunities.
- Coaches Salaries- The club provides the best coaching staff in this region. Our coaches are licensed and provide quality soccer instruction. This year we have our strongest line up yet of coaches and we are still looking to add to our coaching staff. Coaches at Roanoke Star do not just coach for a team – they coach for the club and coaches often help out with additional teams and players.
- Goalkeeping coaching – Roanoke Star has a full time Goalkeeping Director, Coach Will Krause, who is widely regarded as the best GK coach available in the Roanoke Valley. Will is a former DI college GK for Virginia Tech and has completed his NSCAA Advanced National Goalkeeping Diploma, making him not only the best GK coach in the area, but the most qualified! Will is also assisted by a highly qualified and experienced GK staff.
- Continued Coaching Education – every coach at Roanoke Star participates in ongoing coaching education. This involves coaching clinics in Roanoke with the club as well as intensive week long courses run by the NSCAA and USSF. The coaching staff at Roanoke Star is by far the highest qualified staff in the area and the instruction the players receive reflects that.
- College Preparation. Every year Roanoke Star helps numerous players to attend college as a collegiate athlete. In 2009 for instance, 22 players at Roanoke Star went on to play college soccer. This is an incredible achievement for any club and even more impressive when you consider the population base in Roanoke compared to some larger cities. No other club in the Roanoke valley had ANY players go on to play college soccer in 2009. The advice and help in dealing with college coaches that players receive as well as the exposure of playing in only the top level events is an invaluable part of being a Roanoke Star player.
- High School Soccer preparation. Roanoke Star players consistently dominate the local high school and middle school rosters. They also dominate the sport page headlines as the goal scorers, top midfielders, defenders and goalkeepers are more often than not players who have developed in our club. Whether your intention is to play college soccer at the DI level, play professionally in Europe (one of our players is currently playing for Karlsruhe in Germany and another recently played for English

powerhouse, Arsenal FC) or just star for your high school team, Roanoke Star has a development program that will help you achieve your goals.

- European Soccer Trip Experience. Every young soccer player dreams of going to Europe and playing against the best youth players in the world. Roanoke Star soccer players get that opportunity! Every year Roanoke Star is represented by the U14 Girls and U15 Boys teams (Premier and Elite) at the Gothia Cup in Sweden. Known as the World Youth Cup, the tournament is the biggest youth soccer event in the world and is a great soccer and cultural experience that Roanoke Star players will remember for the rest of their lives.
- Additional European Playing Experience – Roanoke Star has recently sent players to Europe to further advance their soccer knowledge and experience. This great opportunity is available in the spring seasons to players who have shown great commitment to the club and are doing very well academically. The players stay with a host family and train with local professional clubs in Europe. Currently, 2 Roanoke Star players are in Europe, 1 in Sweden and 1 in Germany.
- Coaches training equipment – Roanoke Star coaches and players have access to some of the best coaching equipment available. The club also strives to keep abreast of any new advances in equipment and will ensure that players have access to any new equipment or technological advances that becomes available and that will aid in our players development.
- League and governing organizational fees. Roanoke Star teams play in the two best leagues in the area. Other leagues in the area do not come close to offering the competitive nature of the leagues available and the developmental opportunities that each league provides.
- Background checks on all coaches and volunteers through the VYSA. All coaches are required to go through background checks and receive training on crime prevention.
- Regular newsletter – every Roanoke Star player and parent receives regular copies of our newsletter. The circular is easy to read and helps keep players and parents up to date on all the news in the world of soccer as well as specific information on Roanoke Star.
- Sponsor Discounts. Roanoke Star has tremendous links with the local community. Often our sponsors are local businesses and they often offer great discounts to Roanoke Star members.
- On-line registration. Registration and payment is made simple thanks to our on-line capabilities.
- State of the art Adidas Uniforms. Roanoke Star has a great relationship with Adidas. As part of that relationship it is vital that all players play in the same uniform. Since we can guarantee that to Adidas, they give us the best discounts and the best looking uniforms and training gear!
